## **Croft Autosolo and Autotest**

### **Supplementary Regulations**

1. Durham Automobile Club Ltd will organise and promote a Clubmans Autosolo and a Clubmans Autotest on the 16<sup>th</sup> June 2024 at Croft Circuit, Dalton-on-Tees, Darlington DL2 2PL.
2. Held under the General Regulations of the Motorsport UK, (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), and these supplementary regulations
3. Motorsport UK permit Autosolo - 136496  
Motorsport UK permit Autotest - 136497
4. The event is not a round of any Championship
5. The event is open to members of Durham Automobile Club and members of Hartlepool, Whitby, Hadrian, Hexham, Tynemouth, Eden Valley, West Cumbria, South of Scotland, Spadeadam, Whickham and Wigton motor clubs. **Note all competitors (Drivers and Navigator/Passenger) must be in possession of Motorsport UK RS Clubman licence as a minimum.** Available free from [www.motorsportuk.org/competitors/rs-clubman-licence/](http://www.motorsportuk.org/competitors/rs-clubman-licence/)
6. The programme will be:-  
Access to the venue is after 09:00  
The event will start at 10:30  
The test running at 15:00 will become the last test.
7. The event will contain three classes:-  
Autosolo  
A – Front Wheel Drive  
B – Rear Wheel Drive  
Autotest  
C – Cars Not Driven to the event
8. Awards will be TBC (Note only cars in classes A and B can win the Autosolo)
9. The entry list opens on publication of these Regulations and closes on 12<sup>th</sup> June 2023. All entries must be made on the attached entry and e-mailed to Lindsay Burnip at [poshbirdincontrol@btinternet.com](mailto:poshbirdincontrol@btinternet.com), once the entry has been accepted you will be sent online payment details. The entry fee is £30.00.
10. The maximum entry for the event is 30. The minimum entry for the event is 10. The minimum entry for each class is 3 (If less than 3 in a class, classes may be amalgamated at the organiser's discretion). **All vehicles competing in the Autosolo must be driven into the venue and be taxed, insured and have a valid MOT if applicable, the responsibility for this lies with the entrant.** If your car does not

meet these requirements then you must enter the Autotest class C. In the Autosolo classes A and B a passenger is allowed but must be aged 12 years or over. Cars with no hood/hardtop fitted passenger must be 16 years or over. Seat belts must be worn and road tyres only for all vehicles. Note in the Autotest cars in class C passengers are not permitted.

11. All vehicles must comply with Motorsport UK Technical Regulations. Note J5.17.2 cars must be fitted with silencers (VERY IMPORTANT) 100db at 0.5mtrs or 88db at 2mtrs, chart 5.18
12. No practise will be allowed. Judges of fact will observe speeding and dangerous conduct in the competitor car park, also for penalties on tests

14. Provisional results will be posted as soon as possible after the last test. Any protests must be lodged in accordance with the blue book
15. Timing will be by hand held watches, or electronic timing equipment. Start procedure will be on the marshals instruction
16. Competitors will be identified by numbers provided by the organisers which should be placed in the top passenger side of the windscreen.
17. All other general regulations of the MSA apply as written , except
  - M6.6 Pylons may be less than 1 metre high
  - Table M.7c Maximum penalty is fastest in class +20 seconds
  - Table M.7d & e Penalties are 5 seconds per fault for cones and lines
18. All marshals are judges of fact. Any competitor queries must be addressed to the Clerk of the Course.
19. All competitors and official can use the facilities at Croft, food and toilets are available.
