PCT - Production Car Trial

Another cheap entry level form of Motorsport. You have to use a relatively standard road car. Sections are set out in a field usually on a slope.

The idea is to drive your car through a set of posts and reach the top of the slope/section. The further you get the the less penalties you get. The posts near the start have high points and as you progress up the slope the post numbers decrease. Once you cease to move forward due to your vehicle stalling or your wheels spinning the number of the last post you passed is your section score.

Cars must be two wheel drive only and you must carry a passenger and use road tyres. .
